

Hi Mike:

I charted Greg's data that was shown on the video and have an interesting observation that may be of interest. Without getting deeply into statistical analysis, the data charted out as a perfectly "in control" process. That is, the up and down movement of the traffic was all within the boundaries of what the data indicates is "normal" behavior.

Nothing statistically changed or was different from the beginning of June up until Observation 72 in late August with 114 visitors.

Note the graph indicates that at this time the data pushed up past the Upper Control Limit which is based on a calculation of all the data.

What this means is that something happened! :o)

I would suggest that this may be an indication that it probably takes about 3 months before real progress can be seen on getting additional traffic. I consider this a major positive as I have many pages that have been up awhile and haven't seen any real increase in traffic.

This data indicates that it takes about 3 months to start getting really noticed by the Search Engines.
